

STANDING RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANIZATION

At its Sixteenth Session (Buenos Aires), the Assembly, on 20 September 1968, amended:

(a) Rule 1 of its Standing Rules of Procedure as follows:

Rule 1

The Assembly shall meet not less than once in three years and shall be convened by the Council at a suitable time and place Sessions [Convention, Article 48(a)].

Editorial Note: In view of this amendment, the Editorial Note on page 1 of Doc 7600/2 should be deleted.

(b) The first sentence of Rule 10 a) as follows:

Rule 10

- a) The provisional agenda prepared by the Council for an ordinary session shall be communicated to Contracting States so as to reach them at least ninety days before the opening of the session.
- (c) The first sentence of Rule 10 b) as follows:
 - b) Subject to the requirements of paragraph d), any Contracting State may, at least forty days before the date fixed for the opening of an ordinary session, propose to the Secretary General the addition of items to the provisional agenda.
