

STANDING RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANIZATION

At its 22nd Session (13 September – 5 October 1977), the Assembly amended the Standing Rules of Procedure of the Assembly by amending Rules 2 and 65 to read as follows:

Rule 2

The Assembly may hold extraordinary sessions at any time upon the call of the Council or at the request of not less than one-fifth of the total number of Contracting States addressed to the Secretary General [Convention, Article 48(a)].

Extraordinary Sessions

Rule 65

The English, Arabic, French, Russian and Spanish languages may be used in the deliberations of the Assembly and its bodies. Speeches made in any of these five languages shall be interpreted into the other four languages, except where such interpretation is dispensed with by common consent. Languages of deliberations
