

Mr. Gerardo Ezequiel Bompadre took office as Permanent Representative of Argentina to the International Civil Aviation Organization in April 2022. He has been the Consul General of Argentina in Montreal since March 2021.

Before arriving in Montreal he served as Director of International Legal Assistance and Treaties at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Argentine Republic of (2016-2017) and in his previous diplomatic posts, he served at the Embassy of Argentina in Canberra, Australia (1992-1997); the Permanent Mission of Argentina to the Organization of American States (OAS, Washington DC, USA, 2003-2008) and at the Embassy of Argentina in Ottawa, Canada (2011-2016).

Mr. Bompadre was member of Argentine delegations at several bilateral and multilateral meetings and fora related to *non-proliferation and peaceful uses of nuclear energy*, such as the Committee on Hemispheric Security; Inter-American Committee against Terrorism (CICTE); OECD Working Group against Bribery in International Business Transactions; United Nations Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice (CCPCJ), among others.

Mr. Bompadre graduated from the Faculty of Law and Social Sciences, National University of La Plata and the National Foreign Service Institute.
