

Mrs. Paola Alejandra Uribe Raibaudi was appointed Representative of Chile on the ICAO Council on 10 November 2024.

Prior to her posting at ICAO, Mrs. Uribe had a distinguished career in meteorological research and leadership at the Meteorological Directorate of Chile, which is part of the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGAC). During her tenure, she held various key positions, including Head of the Research and Technological Support Section, Investigator, Meteorological Analyst, and Shift Supervisor. Over the past two decades, she has made significant contributions to climate analysis and forecasting, strengthening the institution's capabilities in these areas.

Mrs. Uribe also served on several committees, including the Antarctic Advisory and the Humanitarian Assistance Task Force for Hydrometeorological under the World Meteorological Organization (WMO). Additionally, she was a member of the WMO Executive Council Panel on Polar and High Mountain Observations, Research and Services.

Mrs. Paola Uribe academic credentials include a degree in Meteorological Engineering from the Aeronautical Technical School, a master's degree in meteorology and Climatology from Universidad de Chile, and a master's in Business Management and Public Policy from IEDE Business School and Universidad Europea de Madrid. Her educational background is further complemented by specialized diplomas and courses in leadership, people management, GIS technology, remote sensing, and regional climate modeling.
