

Mr. Brahim Kane was appointed the Representative of the Islamic Republic of Mauritania to the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) on 12 April 2022 and the Representative on the ICAO Council on 4 October 2022.

Prior to his appointment at ICAO, Mr. Kane was Chargé de Mission at the Office of the Prime Minister of the Islamic Republic of Mauritania where he followed the files related to infrastructure and transport.

From 2007 to 2018, Mr. Kane was General Manager of the Mauritanian Airports Company, a mixed economy company to which the State has granted a management mandate for the operation of the ten Mauritanian airports, including Nouakchott International Airport.

In this capacity, he managed the opening and operation of the new Nouakchott Oumtounsy International Airport and launched the certification process of Mauritanian international airports.

Mr. Kane is a graduate of the University of Law and Economic Sciences of Tunis (Tunisia), the University of Law and Economic Sciences of Nice (France) and the School of Maritime Affairs Administration (EAAM) of Bordeaux (France).
