

Mr. Essa Al-Malki was appointed in June 2017 as the first Permanent Representative of the State of Qatar to ICAO. On 4 October 2022, he was elected the Representative of Qatar on the ICAO Council.

Prior to his assignments to ICAO, he served in a number of senior roles at the Qatar Civil Aviation Authority as a legal expert, before assuming the position of Head of the Agreement and International Affairs Section. During this time, Mr. Al-Malki was responsible for the negotiation of air services agreements between Qatar and other States.

Mr. Al-Malki holds a Bachelor's degree in Political Science and Legal Studies from Indiana State University (USA) and a Master's degree in Energy and Resources from Hamad Bin Khalifa University in Qatar.
