Dr. Jaewan Lee was appointed Representative of the Republic of Korea on the ICAO Council on 20 December 2022.

After joining the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) in 1991, Dr. Lee held various diplomatic positions including serving as the First Secretary at the Korean Embassy in Austria and Korean Permanent Mission to the International Organization in Vienna (July 2002); Director, Division for Territory and Oceans, Office of International Organizations, Global Issues and Treaties Trade (MOFAT) (July 2007); Director, Humanitarian Assistance Division, Development Cooperation Bureau (MOFAT) (January 2009); Counsellor at the Korean Permanent Mission to the UN Office and other International Organizations in Geneva (June 2010); Minister and Consul-General at the Korean Embassy in the Philippines (July 2013), and Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (May 2019).

Dr. Lee received a PhD in Graduate School of Law from Korea University, Seoul, a Master of Laws degree in Law School from University in Virginia, USA, and B.A. in College of Law from Korea University, Seoul.

Dr. Lee has received a Service Merit Medal in 2013.
