

Mr. Munyaradzi Waniwa was appointed Permanent Representative of Zimbabwe on the Council of the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) in October 2022. Prior to assuming this role, he was appointed as Alternate Representative of Zambia on the Council in March 2021.

Mr. Waniwa has over 15 years of experience in the aviation industry focusing on international agreements, air transport policy, and regulation. He led several bilateral air service agreement negotiations and championed the successful implementation of the “Open Skies Policy” in Zimbabwe.

Mr. Waniwa also served in expert roles in the Government of Zimbabwe in the Competition and Tariffs Commission and the Division of Economic Affairs in the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development.

Mr. Waniwa graduated with Honours in Economics from the Faculty of Social Sciences at the University of Zimbabwe.
